

Student Fees, Fines and Charges

The Belmont Public Schools may require student user fees for certain sports, activities, music programs and services such as busing, meals, and Full Day Kindergarten. The Belmont Public Schools may also charge for materials and supplies used for activities that supplement the educational program.

Students may be charged for lost or damaged books, materials, supplies, and equipment provided by the Belmont Public Schools.

The Superintendent shall develop procedures to implement this policy including listing of the categories of fees for which reduction or waivers is available and the process required to apply for a reduction or waiver. The Superintendent shall also develop procedures for notification and collection of accounts with an overdue balance that comply with state and federal laws and regulations.
