Finally, Mr. Kale reported that the Financial Task Force has been meeting and collecting information that relates to long-term planning for the Town.

Dr. Kingston reported that he and Mr. DiCologero have been meeting weekly with both the Finance Subcommittee and Mr. Kale regarding the FY'15 budget. He indicated that compensation and increased enrollment are the biggest cost drivers.
